**GIRL:** Can a verb be an adverb?

The girl hands her a dollar and the teacher goes to her change belt for change.

**NARRATOR:** ... South Carolina would get no federal funding for education.

**TEACHER:** Grammar question -- 80 cents.

**TEACHER:** Who still owes on the classroom rent?
